

# Basic Leadership Course (BLC) Packing List - MN Wing Encampment 2025

The listed items are **MANDATORY** (unless otherwise stated). All items must be marked with your last name. All items should be in one suitcase/bag except for one garment bag with blues uniform.

## ABU Uniform

- 2 ABU Blouse with name/CAP tapes and patches sewn on (3 recommended)
- 2 pair ABU Pants (3 recommended)
- 8 tan crew neck T-shirt
- 1 ABU Cover (hat)
- 1 tan ABU Belt
- 7 pair Black or sand Boot Socks (heavy, thick or wool, 10 recommended)
- 1 pair Black Combat Boots (ensure well-broken in)
- 1 pair Boot-blousers (2 recommended)

## Blues Uniform

- 1 Blues Short Sleeve Dress Shirt/Blouse
- 1 pair Blues Pants/Skirt
- 1 Blues Belt with buckle
- 3 White V-Neck T-Shirts
- 1 Flight Cap w/hat device
- 3 pair Black Dress Socks
- 2 pair hose/stockings, neutral color (required if skirt is worn)
- 1 pair Black Blues Shoes (ensure shoes are well broken in)
  - **(NO HEELS OR PUMPS allowed)**
- 1 Cadet Nameplate
- All earned ribbons and badges
- Cardboard for nameplate/ribbons

## PT Uniform

- 2 pair black or dark blue athletic shorts (knee-length)
- 1 pair compression shorts (optional - for wear under PT shorts)
- 11 Pair White Athletic Socks
- 1 pair Athletic PT Shoes (#1 item cadetsforget!)
- 1 pair plain black athletic pants (optional)
- 1 plain PT sweatshirt (optional)
- 2 sports bras (female only, 3 recommended)

## Uniform Accoutrements

- 1 Set of cadet grade insignia (2 recommended)

## Personal Items

- 8 pair underwear
- 3 Bras for wear in uniform (female only)
- 1 Deodorant
- 1 bottle sunscreen
- 1 bottle bug spray
- 1 pack moleskin (band aids recommended)
- 1 Toothbrush
- 1 Toothpaste
- 1 Chapstick (optional)
- 1 Comb/Brush
- 2 Shower Towels
- 2 Wash Cloths
- Shampoo/conditioner
- 1 bar soap with travel container or small bottle of body wash
- 1 pair shower clogs/flip-flops (for wear in shower)
- Razor and Shaving Cream (if needed)
- Female sanitary products (female only)
- 1 Swimsuit (optional - allowed during showers for modesty)
- All needed personal medication/prescriptions (i.e. EpiPen, inhaler)

## Miscellaneous Items

- 1 Ruler, 12-18 Inches in Length
- 1 stitch gage (optional – recommended)
- 1 Yardstick (optional – recommended)
- 1 Lint Roller
- 6 White Plastic Clothes Hangers
- Notebook and Paper (pocket size)
- 4 Pens
- Current CAP ID card
- Shoe Shine Kit/Materials
- 1 Rain Poncho/Jacket
- Female hair products (hair ties, pins, hairspray, etc)
- 1 Laundry Bag
- 1 Flashlight with batteries
- 1 set Civilian Clothes (optional for travel home)
- 1 Iron, Starch (optional)
- 1 Hair Dryer (optional)
- 1 Safety Vest (optional)

### **Contraband**

**The following items are considered contraband and will be confiscated for the duration of the week and returned at the end. Perishable/illegal items will not be returned. This list is NOT all inclusive.**

- *Electronics (phones, ipods, tablets, etc)*
- *Food/Candy/Drinks*
- *Non-religious reading material*
- *Lighters/matches*
- *Weapons (knives, multitools, firearms)*
- *Explosives (ammunition, fireworks)*
- *Alcohol*
- *Tobacco (e-cigs/nicotine)*
- *THC Products*
- *Controlled substances*
